THE HISTORY OF THE PASTY

The pasty (pronounced "pass-tee") was brought to Michigan's Upper Peninsula by Cornish miners in the 1800s. These portable meat pies were the perfect lunch for long days underground; easy to carry, filling, and could stay warm for hours.

Finnish, Italian, and other immigrant miners quickly adopted and adapted the recipe (adding rutabaga, different spices, and breakfast versions). Today, the UP pasty is an iconic symbol of Yooper culture and pride.

Fun Fact: Miners' wives would mark one end with their husband's initials so he could tell his pasty apart in the dark mines!
